We are excited to welcome our newest member to the Board of Trustees, Brian W. Anderson, referred to us by board member Jack Murray. He brings to the board a great business insight to our science and the potential for commercial application, and he has already contributed significantly to TBRI's

strategic planning. Brian works out of Tampa and lives here in St Petersburg with his family.

At our last quarterly Cell-ebration we had a record turnout of 60 attendees, including our Mayor, Bill Foster. Word is growing in the community about our research and if you have not attended this event in the last 6 months, you have missed some of the latest developments from Dr. Guy Bradley regarding our new protocol for cancer treatment. We have made significant progress with our science this past year!

Of exciting news in our burgeoning medical research community is the announcement that New York based IRX Therapeutics will be moving back to the area of its roots, the University of South Florida. It will relocate to St. Petersburg with 40 jobs with the potential to increase to 280. While its eventual home will be in St. Petersburg's Dome Industrial Park, temporarily it will be housed at

In the Lab

In the last issue of our newsletter, TBRI Scientist Dr. Guy Bradley described a new immune-based protocol for the treatment of cancer. The potential of this approach is gaining increased awareness. I have been receiving inquiries from physicians because a number of their patients are experiencing unexpectedly good outcomes using a simplified version of our protocol.

For many decades, physicians have relied on a single primary step to reduce the size of the tumor mass: conventional methods (chemotherapy, radiation and surgery). Our proposed protocol has added two further steps that may prove effective in reducing the size of tumors. To develop a comprehensive cancer treatment protocol, we have focused our efforts on fine-tuning the activation and suppression of the body's immune system. This selective modification of certain immune pathways may result in more effective cancer treatments and with fewer side effects.

Published research papers on complementary/integrative medicine which study the use of dietary supplements do not constitute a mainstream medical interest at this time. However, there is an urgent need to explore this avenue by scientifically rigorous testing. In reality, more than 60% of cancer patients are taking this approach, but it is not currently based on sound science. Indeed, the Society for Integrative Oncology has dedicated itself to the scientific evaluation of such studies and the dissemination of its findings. Their goal is to integrate complementary therapies into the clinical setting.

As I noted above, TBRI has proposed adding two additional steps to current cancer therapy. These steps are designed to favorably enhance the body's immune response to tumors. Much work remains, but we are quite encouraged by the results we have obtained so far. Stay tuned...

P.S.: A highly recommended book describing the history of cancer treatment is "The Emperor of All Maladies: A Biography of Cancer," by Siddhartha Mukherjee.
